#### **Purpose**

Our Mentoring team is committed to improving the overall reach and ability of the mentoring programme to deliver the best possible participant experience and community outcomes. In the role of Mentoring Growth Coordinator, you will act as primary contact between the Mentoring team and the state based marketing and events teams in support of our Mentoring and growth agenda.



## Responsibilities

#### Marketing and Growth [50%]

- Increase awareness of and engagement with the mentoring programme.
- Assist in creating mentoring related marketing collateral.
- Support the marketing team to ideate and implement mentoring growth and acquisition campaigns.
- Ensure all messaging for the mentoring team is consistent with OFA values and goals.
- Engage with the OFA and mentoring community to continuously improve the participant experience and overall outcomes .

## **Events [40%]**

- Partner with the events team and state-based directors to organise, coordinate and run mentoring events on the day.
- Attend OFA events to promote awareness of the mentoring programme and drive acquisition of new participants.

## General [10%]

- Support the Director of Growth with initiatives as required.
- Participate in national, state and team meetings as required.
- Undertake an OFA induction and role onboarding.
- Understand and implement OFA's strategy, vision and mission.
- Uphold the OFA code of conduct.
